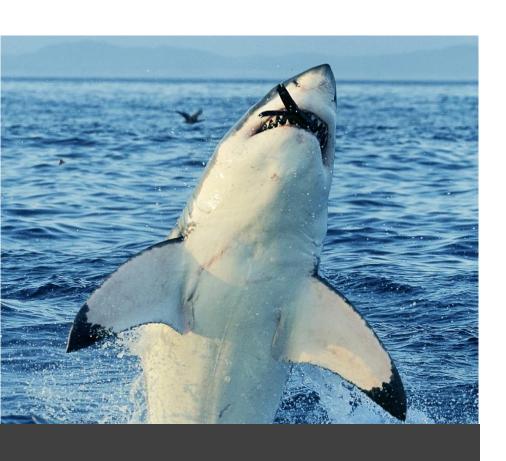


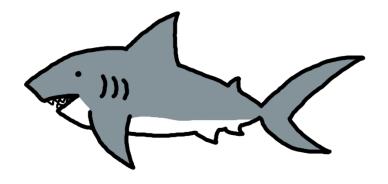

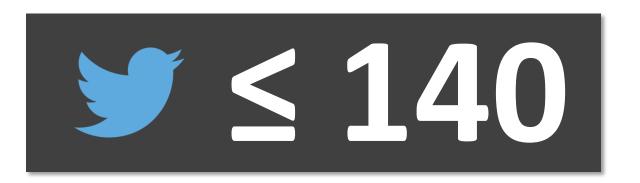
BIG FONTS. SIMPLE FONTS.

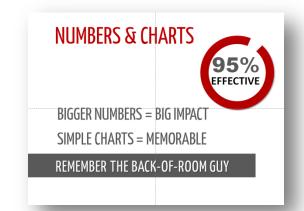

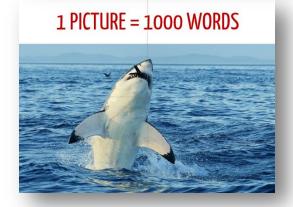

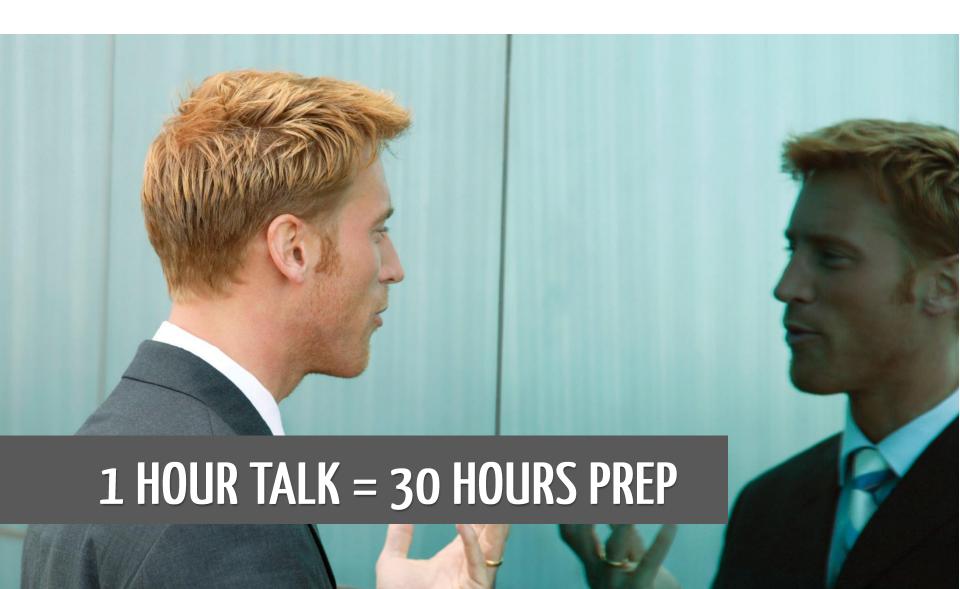
